



## ALTERNATE DROP FACILITY

Sitwell Corporation, a Merida supplier of furniture to IKEA recently opened a large distribution center in Dothan, Alabama and has agreed to allow Linea Peninsular customers with containers heading for Panama City to drop off at their location in the event of a hurricane emergency.

A Linea Peninsular dispatcher will be at the Sitwell location to receive and dispatch your equipment and arrange necessary paperwork.

Because we will not be able to accept further southbound loads at Panama City in this situation, we are requesting our customers drop off their southbound containers at the Sitwell yard 72 hours before expected hurricane landfall, then deadhead to Panama City (80 miles south) to pickup one of their northbound containers.

**If time permits, making additional deadhead trips between Dothan, AL and Panama City, FL (roundtrip about 4 hours) in order to get any additional northbound containers off the dock in Panama City.**

In summary: hold southbound containers in Dothan 72 hours and pickup northbound cargo up in Panama City up to 48 hours before hurricane landfall.

Emergencies always require additional equipment. A recent audit located a large number of empty Linea Peninsular containers on chassis at several customer locations. Please assist us to handle hurricane season emergencies by having this equipment returned to Linea Peninsular.
